NUTMEG TUNEUP 2009

I didn't hold out much hope for the Second Annual "Nutmeg Tuneup" on Saturday, August 22nd. Mother Nature opened up buckets of rain all night and Tropical Storm Bill was drawing a bead on the Northeast. Except for a ten minute break near Waterbury, it rained the whole way from Lower Fairfield County to the Ye Olde Newgate Coon Club. Although Forty people signed up, I was expecting a much lower turnout due to the weather. People started showing up and the rain started tapering off. Then more people arrived and the rain backed down to a drizzle. By 9:45 we had Thirty-two shooters and it had stopped raining! The squads were juggled around and we hit the course.

Joe Gimelli had the usual trickery up his sleeve. There were plenty of technical targets that were easy to see, but hard to hit. In particular, there was an in-your-face looper on station 10 that kind of crossed at about 10 yards. If you were like most people, you waited until it got right in your face and blasted it. If you follow George Masek (HOA, by the way), you realize that you have to get it much sooner to let your pattern work. Joe mixed up the targets and threw lots of deceptive 90s alongside 110s as true pairs.

We experienced the slightest drizzle on the walk back to the sporting clays pavilion at the conclusion of the shoot. Overall, you couldn't ask for a better day of shooting.
